D1 ENTITLEMENT TRAINING



This course provides a step by step process to achieving D1 entitlement for any drivers who passed their test after January 1997 who are planning to drive minibuses for hire or reward.

STEPS 1 –3: (done by individual)

- Apply for provisional licence (D2)
- Undertake a medical (D4)
- Undertake Theory and Hazard perception test at DVLA theory test centre. We can make necessary DSA manuals available for use. (£50 deposit refundable on re-turn).



STEP 4: PRACTICAL DRIVING AND DVLA TEST (vehicle provided)

- Undertake 1 hour practical driving assessment with the instructor
- On road practical driving at recommended hours.
- DSA Test Centre for practical test.

Recommended minimum driving practice (16 hours)



Inclusive of DSA test and 16 hours practical driving.

Hourly charge for any additional practical driving required.

Emergency Evacuation procedures for minibuses



Classroom session and practical in-vehicle training. Essential follow on course to the MIDAS and Passenger Assistant Training Courses.

This course will enable drivers and passenger assistants to:

- Understand and recognise common cause of vehicle fires
- Learn to reduce the risks of vehicle fires
- Take practical steps when dealing with a vehicle fire
- Safely evacuate a passenger carrying vehicle
- Manage vulnerable or disabled passengers in an evacuation
- Manage the emergency until help arrives.
